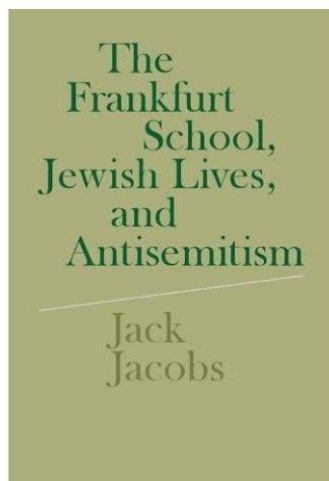

Prof. Jack Jacobs is the author of the book *The Frankfurt School, Jewish Lives, and Antisemitism*, which has just been published by the Cambridge University Press. He is also the author of *On Socialists and 'the Jewish Question' after Marx* (1992) and of *Bundist Counterculture in Interwar Poland* (2009), and the editor of *Jewish Politics in Eastern Europe: The Bund at 100* (2001). Professor Jacobs was a Fulbright Scholar at Tel Aviv University in 1996-1997, and was also a Fulbright Scholar at the Vilnius Yiddish Institute in 2009. Works by him have been translated into French, German, Hebrew, Italian, Japanese, Polish, Russian, and Yiddish.
