Sasha Dehghani studied Islamic Studies, Political Science, Protestant Theology/Religious Studies at the Friedrich Schiller University Jena and at the American University of Beirut. He completed his Ph.D. thesis at the Arabic Department of the Free University of Berlin. Since summer 2012 he has been working at the Research Department of the Bahá'í World Centre in Haifa/Israel. The lecture will highlight a few of the most significant moments of the historical relationship between Germany and the Bahá'í Faith. While reviewing this period the presentation will also take a look at the image of the Bahá'í Faith among some of the more prominent German-speaking intellectuals of Europe.
