

# Call for proposals for the 2023 Annual German Studies Conference, Israel: Language, Culture, Society

We invite scholars in fields related to German studies, including the humanities, social sciences, the arts, and Jewish studies, to submit proposals for talks and panels at the annual German Studies conference, which will be held on 29 June 2023 (The venue is to be announced). Proposals for research related to contemporary or historical aspects of the German-speaking world, including from a comparative perspective, are welcome.

The goal of the conference is to foster connections, collaborations, and the exchange of ideas among Israeli and international scholars of all career stages within the German Studies research community – whether in history, the arts, literature, Jewish studies, the social sciences, political science, law, media, archival studies, or any other relevant area of research.

Faculty, post-doctoral scholars, and graduate students are invited to submit proposals. We are interested in proposals that will contribute scholarly excellence, interdisciplinary perspectives, and variety to the conference program and harbor constructive discussion within a growing scholarly community.

Proposals from any research discipline of the German-speaking world in any period are welcome. We encourage comparative and interdisciplinary contributions that place German issues within a global, transnational, environmental, or theoretical context.

**Contributors are called to propose a single lecture or a panel. We especially encourage panels with a variety of scholars from different stages along their academic path**

- **Talk:** should include a title, the name of the prospective presenter, and an abstract (up to 250 words), along with the presenter's CV.
- **Panel:** should include a title, the names of the three prospective presenters, and their respondents. Please attach an abstract describing the panel's topic and each talk (up to 1,000 words), along with the CV of each participant.

Talks will be twenty minutes long, responses ten minutes long, and panels up to an hour and a half. The deadline for submissions is 12 March. Answers will be given by 04 April. **Please send submissions to [GermanStudiesIsrael@leobaeck.org](mailto:GermanStudiesIsrael@leobaeck.org)**
