

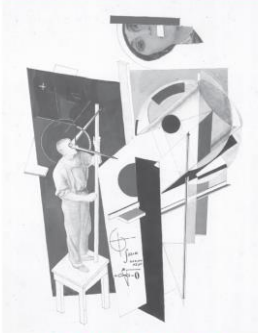

Professor Marina Mogilner holds Edward and Marianna Thaden Chair in Russian and East European Intellectual History at University of Illinois at Chicago. She is a founding coeditor of *Ab Imperio* quarterly, dedicated to new imperial history and studies of nationalism in the post-Soviet space. Her most recent books include *A Race for the Future: Scientific Visions of Modern Russian Jewishness* (Harvard University Press, 2022); edited volume *A Cultural History of Race in the Age of Empire and Nation State (1760–1920)*, for the 6-volume Bloomsbury series “A Cultural History of Race” (Bloomsbury Academic, 2021); and *Homo Imperii: A History of Physical Anthropology in Russia* (University of Nebraska Press, 2013). Her new book, *Jews, Race, and the Politics of Difference. The Case of Vladimir Jabotinsky against the Russian Empire*, is coming out in July, 2023 (Indiana University Press). Mogilner has published widely in various journals and collections on topics such as race and empire, history of human sciences in the Russian Empire, and other.
